Lunch Break Donation



It is well known for long range weather forecasts, astronomical data and advice on a wide variety of subjects including gardening, cooking, fishing and sustainable living. According to the Almanac, we are due for a mixed bag of wintry weather for both December and January. In February, frigid temperatures are due to take hold. Get the snow blowers ready in the East and umbrellas in the West! An active storm track will deliver above-normal precipitation to the Southeast, Northeast and New England states throughout most of the winter, especially February. The Farmers' Almanac is also redflagging February 16-19, when a small, but intense storm develops near the Virginia Capes and delivers a heavy snowstorm with strong winds for parts of the Tennessee Valley, through western North Carolina, the Virginias, Maryland, and Delaware northeast into southern New England – some locations could receive 1 to 2 feet of accumulation! Stay warm and safe this winter!
