#### **Summer Safety**

Summertime is a great time to be outside. Whether you choose to stay in the backyard or hit the beach, staying healthy is easy. Take some precautions to make sure your summer is as safe as it is fun.

Whether it's the weather or the grill, heat is the word of the season.

Too much of it, especially in humid conditions, sucks the water right out of your system. Be sure to drink plenty of fluids so that you don't become dehydrated.

If you don't watch your temperature, you run the risk of heat exhaustion. This comes from a combination of dehydration and an elevated core body temperature. If you are feeling weak, dizzy or nauseous get to a cooler place ASAP and rehydrate.

Sunburns and thermal burns come from different places, but the treatment is usually very similar. Cool the burned area with cool running water. Apply Aloe or other type of cooling agent. To avoid sunburns weara broad spectrum sunscreen of at least SPF 30.

Warm, sunny weather not only brings you outside, it's a call of the wild for all sorts of creatures, too. Spider bites are more common during warm weather, as are dog bites. Snakes, ticks and other bugs are also a bit more feisty in the summer months. Wear insect repellant to help reduce bug bites and be aware of your surroundings to avoid dog and snake bites.
